



## 2022 Year In Review

2022 turned out to be a year of opportunities for ECCCM. We expanded our food services and clothing assistance to include all Catawba County residents. This expansion and increase would not have been possible without the continued support of our donors and the community. Thank you for allowing us to continue giving a hand up to those in need.

# 45%

Total assistance services provided to Catawba County residents increased 45% which included an additional 9,000 services

# 23%

Volunteers increased their hours 23%. Serving a total of 10,476 hours and saving the ministry \$313,756 in salary expenses

# 61%

There was a 61% increase in cost of assistance (crisis services & food purchases) to those in need in Catawba County

# \$1.4M

Over **\$1.4 million** provided for crisis assistance (rent/mortgage, heating and/or cooling assistance, and water)

# \$798

Each household received an **average of \$798** in financial assistance to keep utilities on and/or stop eviction



# 1.7M

Over **1.7 million** pounds distributed through the ECCCM Charlie Bunn Food Pantry

# 18,580

Clients picked up a total of **18,580** carts of food saving our clients an estimated **\$2.9 million**



Thrifty Threads and Treasures thrift store provided clothing vouchers to **220** individuals for a total value of **\$2,214**



Thrift Store sales increased **16.3%** with a total of **10,971** transactions. This supports ECCCM's mission to serve those in need
